### Registration:-

Registration will open from 9.00am on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June

The cost per person is \$5 BBO per person – (Please note on a team of 6 only the 2 pairs starting have to pay.

### Format:-

6 x 10 Board Matches – Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2020 then a Semi-Final & Final which will hopefully be on Viewgraph on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> June

Start time is 11.00am Please make sure to register well in advance – The registration process is NOT simple so trying to register at 10.30am may still be too late.

Please note BBO uses the ACBL 20 point VP scale which is what we are using

Undo's: Please note that Undo's will be switched on in this competition but the Director will only insist on an undo where the laws of bridge allow same in the real world. ie for a mechanical error in bidding and only before your partner has called. Any other request for an undo will be dependent on your opponents allowing same. Please note that in your settings you can set up your profile where it asks you to confirm all your bids, confirm all your cards or confirm both all your bids and all your cards. This will prevent mis-clicks. While slowing your actions a little bit, it certainly will prevent you mis-clicking bids or cards.

## How to Register:-

Registering for teams is slightly different to pairs and there are two possibilities as follows:-

- a) One of your team members must log on under the old flash version, This is a link to the flash version: <a href="https://www.bridgebase.com/client/client.php">https://www.bridgebase.com/client/client.php</a>
  Please note this option is not available on mobile devices or ipads, then the process is as follows:-
  - 1) Make sure all four members are logged onto BBO
  - 2) Ask your team mates to register as a pair for the event by searching for diumraid or CBAI125478 or June Irish Invitational Teams

- 3) Now the user using flash invites his own partner to play (NB this user must have BBO \$
- 4) Now the user using flash invites the team mates to join the team
- 5) Your team will now be registered
- b) If you do not have access to the flash version you can still register as follows:-
  - 1) Make sure all four members are logged into BBO
  - 2) Ask your team mates to register as a pair for the event by searching for diumraid or CBAI125478 or June Irish Invitational Teams
  - 3) Make sure the other three members of your team are online and then Contact "diumraid" the TD by phone 0868236618 or on BBO and give him your BBO Username and Password and he will log in as you. (Please note the member contacting diumraid must have BBO\$)
  - 4) He will then invite your partner and team mates to form a team
  - 5) You then log back in as yourself and you are registered

Please note that all players taking part are expected to play on their own and NOT to allow anyone in the same room as them to Kibitz any table, their own or any other while their match is in play. If you are not prepared to play under these circumstances just let me know and I can withdraw the player before the event.
